Building Project: We praise God and thank you for a wonderful response to our additional pledge appeal made at our EVM 3 weeks ago. Including what can be recovered through GIFT AID, this has amounted to **£91,500** since Pauline presented our situation at the EVM. We have been able to authorise the Contractor to proceed with the works, apart from certain simplifications on the grounds of good stewardship. The most **significant omission will be the tea and coffee point planned for the lobby, which was to be extraordinarily costly (£15,000)** for what we were getting, largely because of very high drainage costs, and the need for it will be met by the new independent access to the kitchen. Although during the consultation, concerns were again raised about the accommodation planned for part of the stage, we are proceeding with this, as it had been carefully considered by the PCC and agreed as an integral part of the scheme to complement the reduction to the size of the office. We will keep you up-to-date with the timing and phasing of the works. Once again, **we thank you for your very generous response, which we believe will bring the building up to scratch for its mission purpose.**
